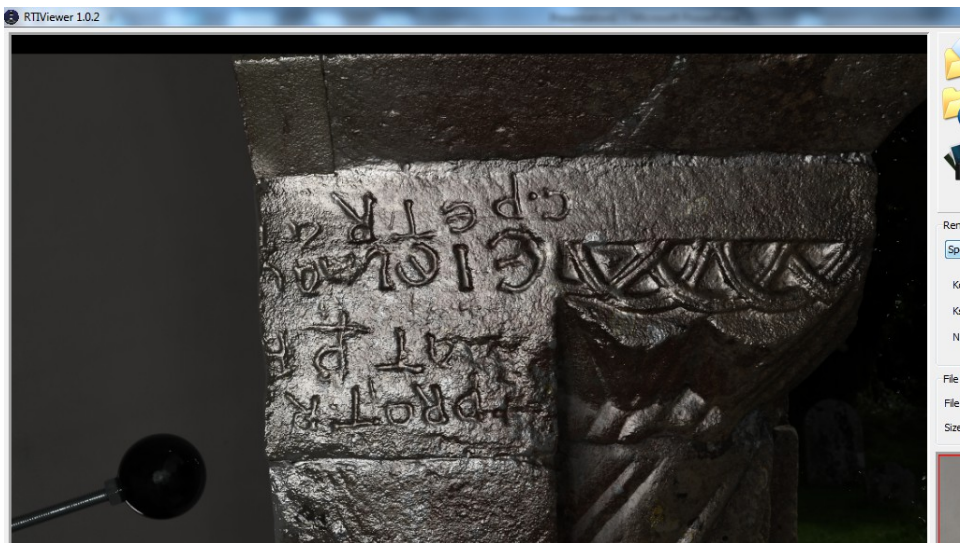


# RTI Reflectance Transformation Imaging

RTI (Reflectance Transformation Imaging) is a photographic recording technique increasingly used by heritage professionals to record memorials and gravestones. It requires minimal digital camera equipment and uses free software to reveal often-hidden details of carved and decorated stone.
