MINUTES

1. Comments from members of the public.

Keith Buck, representing the Triangle and website, wondered if the councillors had signed up to the website email service.

2. Apologies.

There were no apologies for absence.

3. Minutes.

The minutes of the meeting held on 14th May 2012 were agreed and signed..

i) The Chairman congratulated Councillor Crouch on obtaining her Working With Your Council certificate.

It had been noted that the passing places on the road to South Holme were badly potholed and the road at South Holme had been badly flooded during the recent storms.

The Parish Liaison meeting had been held at RDC Malton and among the items discussed were:-new Homes Bonus, Closed Churchyards, Code of Conduct, and the new cardboard and plastic collection which had been delayed.

The seats had been refurbished and reset and a new notice board had been made and erected. The Chairman would write to Mr Apps thanking him for an excellent job.
