16/65 The meeting was opened at 19.00 hours.

16/66 Apologies for Absence

Apologies were received from Cllr F Farnell, County Cllr C Wood, and District Cllr R Wainwright.

16/67 Declaration of Interest on Agenda Items

No declarations were made.

16/68 Items Raised by Members of Public

A resident highlighted that several residents living in the vicinity of the proposed shelter were against it, stating that they felt it would be an eyesore and also highlighted problems experienced with youths. Their views were noted by Councillors and were to be taken into account when making a decision.

16/69 Minutes of Previous Meeting

The minutes of the meeting held on 16th May 2016 were approved by all and signed by the chair.

16/70 Co-option to Fill Vacancies

Two vacancies remained to be filled. One expression of interest has been received to date.

16/71 Exchange of Information and Future Agenda Items

The YLCA Annual Review for 2015/2016 was circulated for information.

16/72 Vacancy for Parish Clerk

The current clerk, Mr C Adnitt, has previously advised the parish council of his intention to retire at the end of August 2016. A replacement Clerk, Gail Cook, has been appointed from 1st September 2016.

16/73 Planning Applications

Six planning applications were received: 16/00442/LBC – approval for external alterations to include erection of a single story extension to existing lean-to extension to include replacement roof and installation of 3 roof lights at, Grapes Inn. Railway

Street, Slingsby.

16/00441/FUL approval to erect a single story extension to existing lean-to extension to include replacement roof and installation of 3 roof lights at, Grapes Inn. Railway Street, Slingsby.

16/00605/HOUSE – approval to erect a rear single storey extension and formation of Vehicular access with parking/turning area to include removal of section of stone front boundary wall with hedge above at, Fishers Cottage, Railway Street, Slingsby.

16/00871/FUL approval to erect a single storey extension to east elevation to form storage area following removal of existing shed at, Village Hall, Church Lane, Slingsby.

16/00311/HOUSE – approval to erect a single story extension to rear elevation at, Yew Tree Cottage, Railway Street, Slingsby.

16/01095/ADV – application to display six site advertisement flags on 5.4m high flagpoles on land east of High Street, Slingsby. No objections were received.

16/74 Village Items.

Street Lights – No issues were reported.

Renewal of Parish Signs – NYCC have refused permission for the proposed signs for South Holme.

16/75 Reports

The chair highlighted recent problems experienced with the local bus service. NYCC were to be contacted to try to resolve the problems with the bus operator.
