

**SLINGSBY, SOUTH HOLME AND FRYTON PARISH COUNCIL MEETING**  
**held in the Village Hall on Monday March 12th 2012 at 7pm.**

**MINUTES**

**Present.** Councillors F Farnell (Chairman), C Crouch, C Wilson, M Singleton, A Shepherd, P Snowball and D Farley (Clerk). District Councillor R Wainright and one member of the public were also present.

**1. Comments from members of the public.**

There were no comments from the public.

**2. Apologies.**

There were no apologies for absence.

**3. Minutes.**

The minutes of the meeting held on January 9<sup>th</sup> 2012 were agreed and signed.

**4. Winter maintenance.**

The snow clearance of the footpaths by B Wilson had been a great success. There had only been three volunteers who had helped with clearing Green Crescent. It was agreed that before next winter there should be a register of volunteers and also people who need help. The Chairman would put a letter of thanks in the Triangle and website.

**5. Meetings for 2012.**

It was agreed to continue with bi-monthly meetings and reconsider next year.

**6. Reports.**

- i) The Chairman reported that there would be a Community Awareness event at Hovingham on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> March .

ii) The Clerk report that:

- No funding had been found for the telephone box yet.
- The new streetlight had been erected but not yet connected.
- The refurbished seats were to be set onto flagstones by J Apps and R Hineby.
- There would be a Neighbourhood Plan event at Pickering on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2-5.45pm.

**7. Parish Assembly.**

It was agreed that the Parish assembly would be held on April 24<sup>th</sup> and would include Digital switchover, Affordable Housing, Streetlights and the new Homes Bonus. An agenda would be delivered to each house a week before the meeting.

**8. Notice board.**

It was agreed to accept the quote from J Apps for the new notice board which would be made of oak and very similar in design to the old one. An application for funding from the Area Committee fund was to be made..

**9. Ryedale Local Plan.**

There were no objections to the Plan .

## **10. Ryedale Citizens Advice Bureau.**

It was agreed to make a donation of £30 to the Citizens Advice Bureau.

## **11. Planning.**

a) The minutes of the planning meetings held on January 23<sup>rd</sup> and February 6<sup>th</sup> 2012 were agreed and signed.

b) Planning decisions:

- Formation of 6 no. Additional hard standings and a caravan storage area and installation of 2 no. Barriers for the Caravan and Camping Club.-Approved.
- Erection of a single storey side extension at The Barn 3 Wheatlands Court Railway Street Slingsby-Approved.
- Erection of two storey extension to side, conservatory to rear, first floor extensions to rear and side and repositioning of entrance gates and stone pillars at the Old post Office- Approved.

## **12. New Homes Bonus.**

It was agreed to consult the electorate at the Parish Assembly for projects to apply for the New Homes Bonus scheme.

## **13. Internal Auditor.**

It was agreed to appoint A Husband as internal auditor for the 2011/12 audit..

## **14. Grass cutting.**

The quote for grass cutting from D Carr was accepted for 2012.

## **15. Seats.**

It was agreed to obtain a quote for treating the seats around the tree on the green in Slingsby and the seats and notice board in Fryton.

## **16. Dog mess.**

Following a complaint by a resident about the dog mess down the Lawns it was agreed to put a dog bin on the streetlight at the junction near the church. The Dog Warden had been informed and had put a number of notices around the village. A notice would also to be put on the website and in the Triangle.

## **!7. Training.**

It was agreed to book YLCA to give training to the Parish Council.

## **18. Jubilee.**

The date for the Jubilee meeting had been set for 24<sup>th</sup> March.

## **19. Youth Club equipment.**

It was decided that the Methodist Chapel would be offered the Youth Club equipment if no one came forward to start a youth club.
