

**. SLINGSBY, SOUTH HOLME AND FRYTON PARISH COUNCIL MEETING
held in the Village Hall on Monday September 10th 2012 at 7pm.**

MINUTES

Present: Councillors F Farnell (Chairman), C Wilson, A Shepherd, M Singleton, P Snowball, C Crouch and D Farley (Clerk). Also present were County Councillor C Wood, M Mackinder and one other member of the public.

County Councillor C Wood told the councillors that:-

- There would be a dead end sign put at the junction with Aspin way due to a number of lorries taking this turning by mistake.
- A hand rail is being put on High street opposite the bus stop.

1. Comments from members of the public.

There were no comments from the public.

2. Apologies.

There were no apologies for absence.

3. Minutes.

The minutes of the meeting held on July 9th 2012 were agreed and signed.

4. Code of Conduct.

Councillors were reminded of the new Code and its disclosure requirements.

5. Village Design Statement.

Mrs Mackinder updated the council on the Village Design Statement. A number of residents had looked at the village and a questionnaire had been distributed to all residents. There had been 21 responses to the questionnaire and these together with the village inspection findings had been displayed at the history event. A draft will be brought to the Parish Council for consideration.

6. Reports.

i)Chairman's report.

- Councillor C Wilson was thanked for cutting the hedge in Green Dyke Lane.

ii) Clerks report.

- The pot holes in Slingsby, South Holme and Fryton were being filled. The drains in South Holme were being cleared.

7. Cemetery.

Councillors would inspect the cemetery on September 14th at 6pm. Charges for 2012-13 would remain the same and be considered again in 2013.

8. Winter Maintenance.

It was agreed to ask Bruce Wilson to clear snow from the village again this year. The new grit bin given by Councillor Wainright from RDC would be kept by Councillor Wilson until a site could be identified.

9. Ward meeting.

There had been a Ward meeting on August 12th at which Councillors and Clerks from Barton le Street and Terrington had been present together with Councillor Farnell and D Farley were present. Councillor R Wainright had explained the new Homes bonus and had suggested a regular Ward meeting be held at least annually. This was agreed.

10. Standing Orders.

It was agreed that Section 7, paragraph d be ammended to read "Councillors with a disclosable pecuniary interest in relation to any item of business being transacted at a meeting may (i) make representations, (ii) answer questions and (iii) give evidence relating to the business being transacted but need not leave the room."

11. Planning.

The minutes of the planning meetings held on 6th August 2012 were agreed.

12. Planning results.

13. Community Investment Fund.

It was agreed to make an application for 10 new streetlights.

14. New Homes Bonus.

It was agreed to make applications for Fryton for refurbishment of seats and notice board and South Holme for a new stone name sign.

It was agreed to request Ryedale District Council for a Housing Needs Survey which would be distributed with the next Triangle.
