1. Comments from members of the public.

Mr & Mrs Farrow spoke to the Council about their proposal to build a house on land in the village.

2. Apologies.

Apologies for absence were received from Councillors A Shepherd and P Snowball.

3. Minutes.

i).The minutes of the meeting held on July 11th 2011 were agreed and signed.

4. Broadband.

Philip Beadnall from a broadband company who have been working with Ryedale District Council to make broadband available to everyone in Ryedale, spoke about their proposals for in this area. Their broadband does not rely on telephone wires but is connected by microwave type masts.

5. Standing Orders.

This item was deferred until the next meeting.

6. Mobile library.

The present mobile Library is to be replaced by the super mobile and will call at Slingsby on alternate Friday afternoons. The Councillors discussed three options for stopping places and agreed that near the telephone box would be the best place..

A quote was received for refurbishment of 7 seats in the village, three of which are cast iron and may be eligible for funding from the small Scale Enhancement Heritage grant.
