**16/01** The meeting was opened at 19.00 hours.

**16/02 Apologies for Absence**

Apologies were received from Cllr F Farnell, County Cllr C Wood, District Cllr R Wainwright.

**16/03 Items Raised by Members of Public**

Four traffic cones have been left in Railway Street which required removal.

A resident enquired about progress with the Parish Plan survey. The results were being collated and a report would be given at the Annual Parish Meeting.

**16/04 Declaration of Interest on Agenda Items**

Cllr A Shepherd declared an interest in item 16/09

**16/05 Minutes of Previous Meeting**

The minutes of the meeting held on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2015 were approved by all and signed by the chair.

**16/06 Co-option to Fill Vacancies**

Two vacancies remained to be filled. To date no expressions of interest have been received.

**16/07 Exchange of Information and Future Agenda Items**

No items were raised.

**16/08 Annual Parish Meeting**

Following discussion it was agreed to hold the Annual Parish Meeting on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> April 2016. Various items were raised for discussion at the meeting.

**16/09 Planning Applications**

Two planning applications were received: 15/01323/MFUL – revised application to build 18 new houses including garages and parking spaces on land to the east side of High Street, Slingsby. Concerns were raised about the capacity of the drainage & sewage systems to cope with the increase volume generated by this development.

Cllr A Shepherd declared an interest in this item and abstained. 15/01323/MFUL –

application to fell trees in a conservation area at, The Old Rectory, The Lawns, Slingsby. No objections were received.

**16/10 Village Items.**

Street Lights – No issues were raised.

Phone Box – Work has now been completed.

Defibrillator –The defibrillator has been installed in the phone box and training took place 9<sup>th</sup> December 2015. Further training on its use is to be arranged.

Highways issues – Work on the Inner Balkside has been completed. Traffic bollards left in Railway Street and mud on the road in Fryton, were to be reported to NYCC for action.

**16/11 Reports**

A written report was submitted by the clerk. The chair advised that approximately 25 people attending the defibrillator training on 9<sup>th</sup> December.

**16/12 Finance**

No payments were received.

Payments due: Clerks Salary & Expenses £276.57 HMRC (Tax) £51.00, York Plastics (Phone Box) £45.60. These were approved by all.

The clerk highlighted the need set up a workplace pension scheme to comply with the law, with the start date for this parish council being 1<sup>st</sup> May 2017. Various options to achieve this were discussed, which would be reviewed further at the next meeting.
