2. County Councillor Caroline Goodrick

The Chairman welcomed County Councillor Caroline Goodrick to the Parish Council meeting and thanked her for attending.

North Yorkshire County Council are have allocated an additional £20,000,000 into schools.

They are currently reviewing the Emergency Plan for North Yorkshire in view of the Grenville Tower incident.

There will be a new tranche of money for the road repairs which North Yorkshire will be bidding for.

Funding has been secured to dual the A64 from the Hopgrove roundabout to the Jinnah restaurant, planning permission in currently being obtained at the moment.

Due to the double fatalities at Welburn and Crambeck solutions will be put in place within 12 to 24 months.

Highways England have confirmed that improvements to the Barton Hill junction will start in November 2017.

Cllr Goodrick has asked for a Level 3 safety check at Scotsmans Lane, which will take place as soon as possible.
