(d) **Village Drainage Survey**

Following stormy weather and heavy rainfall the Slingsby sewerage system has raised concerns. Manholes have been raised causing raw sewage to be visible in the village. Cllr Wilson reported on the advice received from a professional with regard to the sewerage system.
