- 16/16 The meeting was opened at 19.00 hours.
- 16/17 Apologies for Absence
Apologies were received from County Cllr C Wood, and District Cllr R Wainwright.
- 16/18 Declaration of Interest on Agenda Items
Cllr F Farnell declared an interest in item 16/24
- 16/19 Items Raised by Members of Public
A resident felt that a dog bin was required on High Street. Councillors were agreeable to this subject to a suitable location being identified.
A questing was asked about a damaged grit bin. The chair advised that we was about to replace it with a new one.
It was highlighted that two Car Boot Sales have been arranged, and problems with parking at previous events was discussed.
A gate on a footpath through Castle Farm was in need of repair together with line wiring in the vicinity. NYCC were to be contacted to undertake repairs.
- 16/20 Minutes of Previous Meeting
The minutes of the meeting held on 18th January 2016 were approved by all and signed by the chair.
- 16/21 Co-option to Fill Vacancies
Two vacancies remained to be filled. To date no expressions of interest have been received.
- 16/22 Exchange of Information and Future Agenda Items
A letter was received from Tower Mint Ltd offering Commemorative Medals for sale to celebrate the Queens 90th Birthday. Following discussion it was agreed to organise sufficient to provide one to each child aged 11 and under living in the village.

The Queens 90th Birthday celebrations were to go ahead, and the Parish Council has been asked to provide a donation towards the costs. Cllr A Shepherd proposed that a donation of £50 should be made seconded by Cllr F Farnell and was approved by all.
- 16/23 Annual Parish Meeting

2016. A leaflet drop was to be arranged prior to the meeting.

16/24 Planning Applications

Seven planning applications were received: 15/01323/MFUL – approval to build 18 new houses including garages and parking spaces on land to the east side of High Street, Slingsby.

NYCC C3/15/01531/CPO – approval for work to be carried out on a listed building at, Slingsby Primary School, The Green, Slingsby.

16/00186/CAT – application to remove an Ash Tree at, Slingsby Castle, High Street, Slingsby. No objections received.

16/00202/HOUSE – application to install an oil tank at, Glebe Cottage, High Street, Slingsby. No objections received.

16/00350/CAT – application to fell a Leyland Cypress tree at, Candy Cottage, Green Dyke Lane, Slingsby. No objections were received.

16/00311/HOUSE – application to erect a single storey extension to rear elevation at, Yew Tree Cottage, Railway Street, Slingsby. No objections were received.

16/00323/FUL – application to erect a three bedroom dwelling and attached garage with formation of vehicular access on land north of, Yew Tree Cottage, Railway Street, Slingsby. Objections were received concerning the over development of the site as it was felt to be too small for the proposed building. The lack of parking provision was also of concern.

16/25 Village Items.

Street Lights – A street light was out and was to be reported to NYCC for action.

Highways issues – A number of heavy good vehicles have been seen going through the village who were obviously lost, with some damage caused whilst trying to manoeuvre. Following discussion it was felt that better signage was required and the white lining required repainting, NYCC were to be contacted for action.

A blocked drain required cleaning out on Fryton Lane, near to The Old Rectory, NYCC were to be contacted for action.

16/26 Reports

A written report was submitted by the clerk. The chair advised that the light at the school has been sorted out. A contractor has been instructed to get the trees at the back of the cemetery cut back.

16/27 Finance

Payments received: S C Bainbridge (2 x Burial Fees) £590, E Agar (fee for Cremated Remains) £142 and Slingsby Allotments Association £371.

Payments due: Clerks Salary & Expenses £258.24 HMRC (Tax) £50.80, YLCA membership for 2016/17 £278. These were approved by all.

16/28 The Annual Parish Meeting was arranged for 25th April 2016 starting at 1900 hours. The next meeting including the AGM was arranged for 16th May 2016, starting at 19.00 hours.
