18.58 Review of Slingsby Parish Council Standing Orders

The Clerk presented the amendments to the Standing Orders which are recommended due to the new General Data Protection Regulations. Members approved these changes.

18.59 Government Proposals to Categorise Fracking as Permitted Development

Members of the Parish Council discussed the new government proposals to allow the large scale industrial process of shale gas exploration to be exempt from the present local planning system which is intended for low impact domestic development such as building a conservatory.

18.60 Housing Needs Survey Results

Colin Huby, Rural Housing Enabler, Ryedale District Council presented the results from the Slingsby Housing Needs Survey Report. The survey responses illustrate that there is a small, demonstrable local housing need in Slingsby Parish. All 14 respondents have both a housing need and a local connection to the parish.
