RESOLVED Further to the original response, please see the Parish Council's Revised response:-

The Parish Council would like to object to the planning application following several neighbours coming forward with significant concerns with regard to the development. The height and scale of the proposed car port would have a substantial detrimental impact on several adjoining neighbours. A more modest flat roofed car port would be more in keeping and reduce the impact on neighbours. This would appear sensible, given that the solar panels are not required as part of the heating system for the property.

The Parish Council are also concerned to note that not all boundary properties adjoining the application site were consulted.

(c) Dog Fouling

Intelligence on dog fouling issues to be reported to the clerk. Not picking up after your dog can lead to a fine of up to £1,000.

Members to look into the possibility of purchasing additional dog waste bins at Fryton and on Railway Street.

(d) Village Drainage Survey

Information has been received from the Environment Agency and Yorkshire Water. Members to look into this in detail and report back at future meetings.

- (e) **Speeding**
Residents have requested that the NYP speed camera van be deployed in the village as much as possible. NYP Beat Manager PC Jane Jones to carry out hand held speed checks when duties permit.
- (f) **Cemetery Maintenance**
Mr Dawson has carried out a headstone check and is fully insured to carry out this work. Members would like to remind residents that this work can only be carried out by a contractor with adequate insurance cover only. Headstones laid on the floor are dangerous and must not be moved.
- (g) **Verge, Hedge & Footpath Maintenance**
The hedge on Green Dyke Lane to the cemetery has now been cut

Clerk to contact the tenants of the Parish Field with regard to cutting back the hedge before 28th February 2020.
- (h) **Green Dyke Lane Sign**
An additional street sign has been purchased, permission from Castle Howard Estate has been granted and the sign will be installed as soon as possible.
- (i) **Fryton Bench Replacement**
The replacement bench will be delivered week commencing 16th September 2019 and will be installed in due course.
