Cllrs Bairstow kindly offered to fill the salt bins and all councillors agreed that a gritting route needed to be agreed in due course.

Cllr Bairstow to collect a new multi use waste bin to be installed at the top of Baxton Howe (once permission has been obtained from NYC and it has been confirmed that this location is within the Parish).

**(e) Parish Christmas Tree & Lights**

The electrical socket has now been installed. Cllr Bairstow to purchase a tree and lights.

**(f) Vehicle Activated Signs**

The Parish Council are working with TWS to mitigate issues with regard to the new VAS.
